- Learn how to reach the appropriate audience for your songs.



JORI VAN GERMERT Artist, songwriter, vocal coach

Jori van Gemert is a Dutch artist, songwriter and vocal coach who uses music as a tool for expression, connection and change. She graduated from the Rock Academy and now coaches young talents preparing for admission to this university-level music program. In addition, she leads various vocal groups and choirs, focusing on musicality, harmony and building confidence.

Outside of her work as a coach, Jori performs under the name <u>Cloud Cukkoo</u>: a glitter dress, disarming honesty and 'danceable depression' wrapped in dreamy indie pop. On stage, she creates a world of her own - a place where everyone is welcome to land without shame, through humor, vulnerability and fearless storytelling.

JOCHEN SCHELL Songs for rights founder & director

Jochen is the founder and director of Songs for Rights, an international initiative that uses music to promote human rights, participation, and social justice. With a background in communications and journalism, he has lived and worked in over 10 countries across 4 continents and holds a Master's in Children's Rights.

Driven by his passion for music and social change, Jochen created the Songs for Rights LACPA method and led the first workshop in Accra, Ghana, in 2012. Since then, he has been developing the approach through international workshops, trainings, and projects that empower (young) people to raise their voices through music.
